Budget Update

FY 24 Budget Construction

We have built a balanced budget of \$59,842,083 for FY24.

<u>Highlights</u>

- Revenue budget was built with a 1.3% decline in overall enrollment, which amounts to a decline of \$1.3M in revenue.
- FY24 budget included a 3% salary increase for eligible full-time faculty, staff and adjuncts.
- Our state appropriation grew by \$768K, with potential for an additional \$252K.

<u>Challenges</u>

- The use of \$1.3M in cash was needed to offset the system wide elimination of the per-credit distance education fee.
- Continued reliance on salary savings to offset historically under budgeted items (Athletics, Adjunct Instruction, Marketing, and other programs) of approximately \$2.5M.
