



Reflecting on our 2020-2021 Accomplishments

Access and Student Success

- Ranked by U.S. News as 50th for social mobility among
 Midwest regional universities, recognizing good graduation rates among students who receive federal Pell Grants.
- Partnering with the Community Foundation of St. Joseph County on a Lilly Endowment grant to support IU South Bend's 21st Century Scholar Success Initiative.
- A Digital Skills Accelerator grant from the LIFT Network is helping us enhance digital skills for K-12 students and teachers, adult learners, and degree seekers in Elkhart and St. Joseph County.



Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion

- Nearly 100 programs and initiatives focused on Title IX and/or DEI during academic year 2020-2021 impacting more than 3,700 individuals.
- First IU campus to earn Military Friendly designation.
- \$125,000 grant from the IU Pandemic Health Disparities Fund to support a counselor focused on the needs of our diverse students' mental well-being.
- Building naming review process to ensure naming aligns with our values.
- Partnered with 100 Black Men of Greater South Bend on COVID PSA specific to the needs of the Black Community and vaccine clinic at CRHC.

Community Engagement

- Dwyer College providing vaccination training for retired medical workers and community vaccine clinic in partnership with HealthLinc.
- Formation of Community Engagement Center.
- Grant from the Community Foundation of Elkhart County to expand our reach in Elkhart.
- Economic Impact Study showing:
 - IU South Bend created \$364.1 million for the regional economy in FY 2018-19.
 - One out of every 77 jobs in the region is supported by IUSB activities.
 - For every \$1 student invest in their education at IUSB they receive \$4.30 in higher lifetime earnings.

Ended FY21 with nearly \$400,000 in year end savings.



Enrollment Trends



Enrollment Highlights

- Continuing student enrollment is down significantly in all classes except Seniors.
- Incoming class size is also down but:
 - Almost tripled African American transfer students (8 to 23).
 - 143 Hispanic new undergraduate students, consistent with last year.
- New graduate students increased from 140 to 151 this year (8%).
 - Twice the number of new African American graduate students (11 to 23).
 - Tripled the number of new multiracial graduate students (3 to 9).
- Strategic Enrollment Management team is working with others on implementation of a new Retention Action Management Plan.



Diversity, Equity and Inclusion

- Focus on recruitment, hiring, and retention of faculty and staff from historically underserved populations.
- Review policies and procedures that disproportionately and negatively impact historically underserved populations on campus.
- Identify more inclusive spaces and programs for professional development & support.
- Continuing our trajectory towards becoming a Hispanic Serving Institution.
- Launching autism spectrum and foster care support programs for students.
- Continuing to build up 21st Century Scholars program.



Simulation and Innovation Center

 Received a grant from the Dwyer Trust to support feasibility, planning and design of a modern Simulation and Innovation Center.

Goals:

- Advance health science education, training and innovation,
 as well as health systems outcomes across North Central Indiana.
- Provide students exposure to telehealth technology, among other current technological advancements such as virtual cadavers.



 Offer education and training for both students and healthcare professionals in a high-tech medical setting as well as an environment for business and industry innovation.
