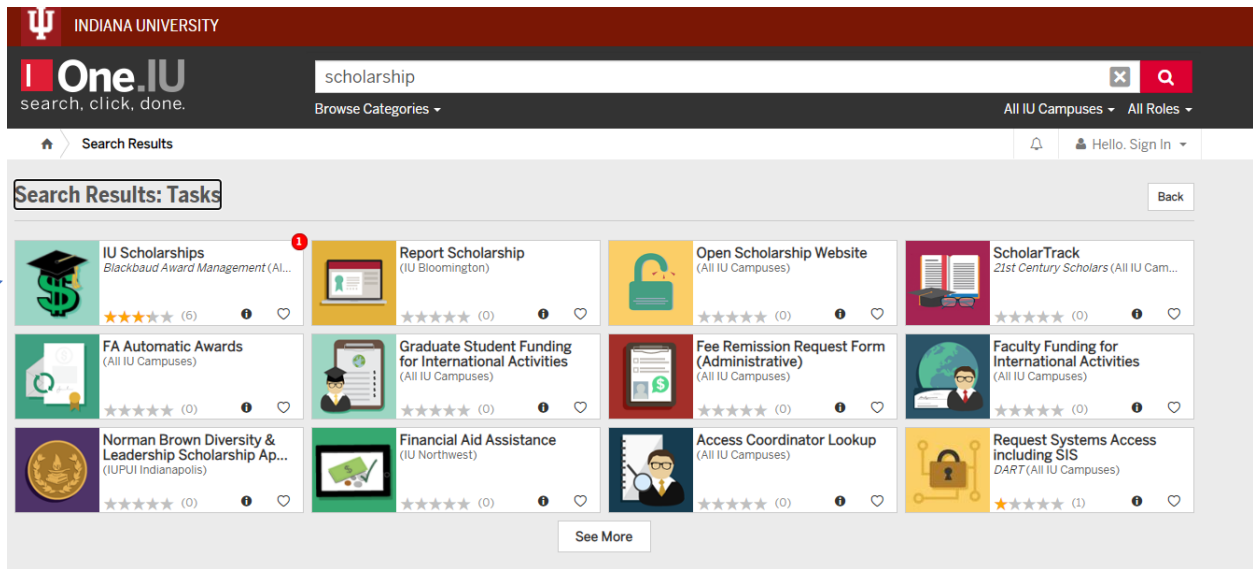


Applying for Scholarships via the IU Online Scholarship Application

The IU Online Scholarship Application opens October 1st.

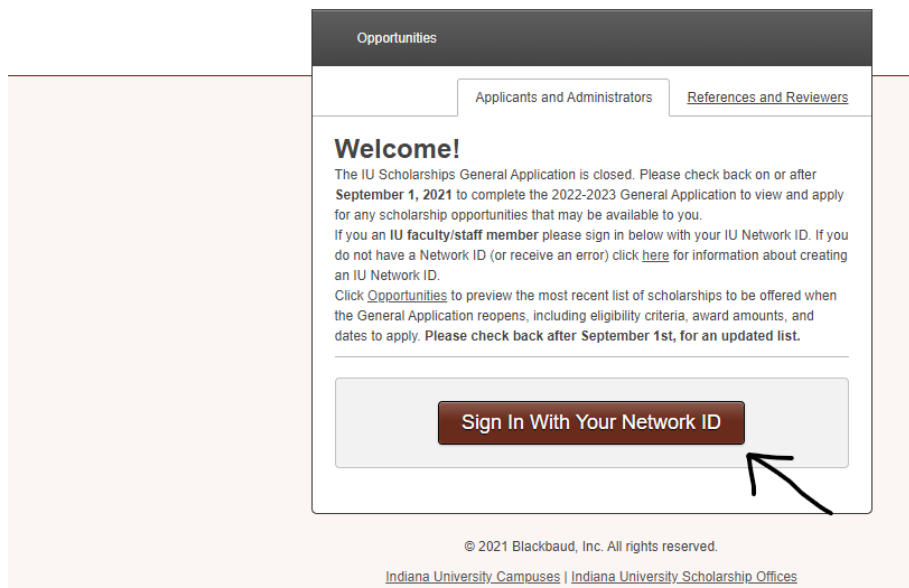
Apply early, there are over 200 scholarship opportunities!

1. Once you receive your admission decision from the university, you may apply for IU scholarships! Remember, to follow the directions in your admissions packet to set up your IU username and passphrase. For assistance on this you may contact the Helpdesk at 574-520-5555.
2. Log into your One.iu.edu account with your IU username and passphrase credentials.
3. Search “Scholarships” and click the tile with the dollar sign in the graduation cap.

4. After clicking “start”, the landing page will ask you to “sign in” with your IU credentials. You will then be prompted with the “Welcome” screen and need to click the red button in the middle of the page.

5. Now you can begin completing the **“General Scholarship Application”**
 - a. You have to **submit** the application to be considered for scholarships. The system will allow you to save it multiple times so don't forget to **“submit”**.
 - b. Next, look to see what “recommended” opportunities you may apply to base on your responses to the General Scholarship Application.
 - i. These applications require a little more information such as perhaps a specific essay response, name of a reference for a recommendation, or documentation of extracurricular participation
 - ii. If you're an incoming freshman from high school, look to see if you qualify to complete the **“Selective Student Scholarships Application”**. **This application has a January due date. Refer to our webpage for exact date.**
6. Remember to complete and **Submit** your applications by the **March 1st** deadline for scholarship consideration.
7. For maximum consideration, for scholarships that consider financial need, complete your FAFSA by March 1st.
8. Check your IU email and the Daily Titan often for new opportunities to apply to.
